## HEADLICE

There has been a number of cases of head lice in school this week. Please check your child's hair over the weekend. If you find head lice or eggs in your child's hair please treat the whole family. If head lice re-occur a few days after treatment it is likely that some eggs were missed and they have hatched. For this reason, you should not only apply the treatment, but also pick off the eggs to avoid re-infection and comb hair with a nit comb everyday for at least 2 weeks.
