Hair and make up

Children should not come to school with extreme haircuts (mohicans, mowhawks, tramlines or rat's tails) or colouring that could serve as a distraction to other children.

Hair bands, clips etc should be discreet designs in colours compatible with school colours and only used in order to keep hair in place. Some hair ornaments may need to be removed for PE on the grounds of health and safety.

No makeup or nail varnish should be worn during the school day. Similarly, temporary transfers or fake 'tattoos' are not appropriate.
