A huge well done to Year 6! SATs results were released this week and all of the children's hard work has resulted in fantastic outcomes. We have exceeded all expectations! The percentage of children in Year 6 achieving age related expectations for Reading, Writing and Maths has increased by 29% and we are now in line with National expectations of performance. All children and staff have worked exceptionally hard to achieve this and I am extremely impressed with the results.

During this week all class teachers have been involved in Pupil Progress Meetings, it has been a pleasure to hear about all the excellent work and progress children have been making over the year.

Classes really enjoyed meeting their new teachers last week and completed some great work with them: the excitement and positive response was incredible! Any classes who did not have the opportunity to meet their new teacher will do so next week.

Next week is our last week of the school year with the final day being Friday 20th July. All children will be taking part in interesting educational projects within their year group which will support them in their learning. We will be watching Rock Steady performances on Monday morning and the Year 6 production will take place on Wednesday evening, I am looking forward to watching these!
